Airplane and Engine Requirements:

All planes will be checked out at some point during this weekend event

All Nitro Powered or Electric planes are invited to fly per following requirements:

Minimum 52 Inch Wingspan

4.0 lbs Minimum Weight RTF—No Fuel

.49 cu. In or smaller 2 stroke

.65 cu. In or smaller 4 stroke

Electric Motors: 900 Watt Max output

SPC Competitive Fun Fly

Fri. June 21 2012 5pm—dusk

A fun fly with 4 mini contests, each designed to test the pilots skill and daring, and nerves:

- Roop Touch and Go (5 passes)
- 1 minute Timed Aerobatic Flight
- Random Event
- Random Event

Pilots will be ranked according to completion times for each event, with points awarded for each rank. Prizes to be awarded to the pilots finishing 1st, 2nd, and 3rd for this event.

SPC Pylon Racing Event

Sat June 22 2012 11am—3pm

Two Pylons - 400' apart; 4 pilots per heat; 10 laps per heat, and 5 heats of extreme aerial racing. Always a crowd pleaser.....

Pilots are on their honor to use 10%-15% standard sport fuel.

Pilots will accumulate points during each of the five rounds of the event. Prizes will be awarded to the pilots finishing 1st, 2nd, and 3rd for this event.

SPC Combat Event

Sun June 23 2012 11am—3pm

We all know what this means: Pilots competing in 3-5 intense rounds of aerial combat, protecting their own 30' streamer and getting their opponents streamers.

30' crepe paper streamers and 5' Leader strings will be provided.

Points will be awarded for each "cut" as well as remaining streamer length. Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place finishers.
